HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

 facilities and arrangements for the welfare of employees.

Objectives for Health & Safety will be set, and their progress reviewed, at Management Review.

This policy will be reviewed at least annually.

We firmly believe that the success of this policy relies on the full co-operation of all employees; therefore, we will ensure that it is brought to their notice, and that they or their representatives are consulted on matters of health & safety. It is our intention for competent persons to regularly review this policy, to take account of any significant changes in the company's operations.
